Shall the previously expired voted increase in the tax limitation imposed under Article IX, Sec. 6 of the Michigan Constitution in Peaine Township of up to .75 mills (\$.75 per \$1,000 of taxable value), as reduced to .7311 mills (\$.7311 per \$1,000 of taxable value) by the required millage rollbacks, be renewed at and increased up to .75 mills (\$.75 per \$1,000 of taxable value) and levied for three years, 2026 through 2028 inclusive, for the purpose of airport operation and maintenance, the revenues of which will be distributed to the Beaver Island Airport Commission, raising an estimated \$68,953 in the first year that the millage is levied? The estimate of the revenue the Beaver Island District Library will collect in the first year of levy (2026) if the millage is approved and levied by the Library is approximately \$159,000.
